Abstract: The Lawrence Schools Collection contains the convent, school and student records for St. Mary's School, Holy Rosary School, St. Augustine's School, St. Rita's School, St. Laurence's School, the Notre Dame Education Center and the Notre Dame Christo Rey High School.

Provenance: The bulk of the collection was given to the archives after the closing of St. Mary's School in 1996. The remainder of the papers were donated around 2010.

Processing: The collection was processed and arranged in 2016.

Conservation Work: Pages were unfolded and boxes constructed for fragile volumes.

Restrictions: The collection is available for research only in the New England Archives of the East West Province of the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur in Ipswich, MA. The Board of Directors' Papers for the Notre Dame Education Center are restricted until 2050.

History of the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur in the Lawrence Schools—The creation of Lawrence, Massachusetts as a planned city devoted to profit began in the 1830s. Speculators bought property alongside the Merrimack River in Andover and Methuen. Their vision was the formation of a city where the river would power their new mills. In 1845, these speculators were incorporated as the Essex Company. The Essex Company laid out the streets in this newly formed town and sold the land to

churches, mill owners, schools, and the emerging local government with restrictions that outlined how the land could be used, as well as how many and what type of buildings were allowed. The new mill workers who poured into this area were mostly Irish immigrants and they were housed in tenements that were rented from the Essex Company. This new community was named for one of the Essex Company investors, Abbot Lawrence. It is rather ironic that Abbot Lawrence never set foot in the city. While other mill cities had similar tenements and rules for their workers, the Essex Company exerted more control over their workers than any other mill town at the time. Their need for control extended to the river – without the Merrimack, their success would be jeopardized. And so, the Essex Company partnered with the city of Lowell's Proprietors of Locks and Canals to buy the water rights of the river from Massachusetts all the way north to Lake Winnepesaukee.

St. Mary's Parish in Lawrence was founded with the beginning of Lawrence in 1848. The first pastor, Fr. James O'Donnell oversaw the construction of a chapel for the parish in 1849. The city continued to grow around the chapel. More mills were completed and more workers arrived. In 1857, Fr. O'Donnell wrote to Sister Louise Van der Schrieck, the American Superior of the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur in Cincinnati, to ask if she could send some Sisters to take over the parish school for girls. Though she agreed to his request, there were not enough sisters available at that time.

In 1859, five sisters were finally ready to travel to Lawrence. Fr. O'Donnell planned to offer the new sisters the attic floor of the building where he lived. It was fortunate that Sister Louise decided to visit a few months before the Sisters' scheduled arrival. It gave her the chance to inspect the building. When Sister Louise "asked to see the preparations for which were being made. . .Fr. O'Donnell insisted that they must first see his children and led the way to the class-rooms." [St. Mary's Convent Annals, 1859-1907] While Sister Louise was pleased with the classes, she still wished to visit the attic rooms Fr. O'Donnell had set aside for her sisters. The Annalist reported that the attic "was divided into five apartments, each ventilated and lighted by a single sky-light. On entering you had to stoop, so as not to strike the ceiling or knock your eye out by the projecting rod. A room at the west end, had the luxury of a sash window and green shutters. . .The floor was made of rough boards without much support, as they extended across the width of the building. In stepping upon them you felt as though they were giving way, and you were to fall through space. In consequence, Sister Superior did not go far, her dread and consternation being evidently visible." " [St. Mary's Convent Annals, 1859-1907] It was obvious the attic rooms wouldn't suffice. At Sr. Louise's insistence, Fr. O'Donnell found a tenement house and had it converted into a livable home.

The first five sisters arrived in Lawrence on Saturday, August 20, 1859. They quickly settled in and opened school on Monday, August 29th, with about 300 girls in three primary grades. Enrollment continued to increase yearly.

With the success of St. Mary's Schools and the growing population of Lawrence, the Sisters began teaching at St. Rita's School in 1902, at St. Augustine's School in 1914, at Holy Rosary School in 1916 and St. Laurence O'Toole School in 1923.

By the 1990s, only St. Mary's School was still being managed by the Sisters of Notre Dame. But when the SNDs realized that St. Mary's School had to close in 1996, they began the work to explore ways to maintain their presence and ministry to the people of that city. This led to the opening of the Notre Dame Education Center in 1996 and the Notre Dame Cristo Rey High School in 2004.

Scope and Content of Collection

The bulk of the collection contains the records for the first school of the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur in that city, St. Mary's. The records include the convent register for the sisters who lived at St. Mary's convent between 1900 and 1935. The convent journals detail the nearly daily events in the convent and school. From these records, a Sister wrote the Annals, which present a yearly overview of the life and work of the sisters in the city of Lawrence. The Annals also occasionally describe events in the city and nearby communities. Among events of note included in the Annals were the 1860 collapse of the Pemberton Mills, the 1890 tornado that left a path of destruction near the Merrimack River, the 1912 Bread and Roses strike, numerous epidemics, including the 1918 Influenza pandemic that struck Massachusetts beginning the end of August 1918 and lasted through much of the fall. When the schools were closed near the end of September 1918, in an effort to contain the spread of the virus, the Sisters of Notre Dame in Lawrence, as well as sisters serving in other communities throughout Massachusetts, volunteered to assist with the growing number of patients. Their work is recorded in the Annals. Also included with the papers are the citations they received for their work among the sick.

The convent papers include documents regarding the visits of their Congregational Superiors, correspondence kept by the sisters, information and brochures for events in the schools, including high school commencements, papers created by student councils in the mid to late 1960s, student newsletters, newspapers and other publications created by students; Jubilees held by the sisters in honor of anniversaries; and records and documents created by the Alumnae Association. The collection also includes 7 scrapbooks. The 1934 scrapbook created for the 75th anniversary of the Sisters of Notre Dame in Lawrence contains news clippings, tickets and invitations to celebrations as well many art deco drawings created by one of the school's alumnae. The remainder of the scrapbooks include newspaper clippings of school and sporting events.

The St. Mary's School Registers range from 1879 to 1939 and list student names, their ages, parental information and place of residence. The collection also contains First

Communion records, Confirmation records, school yearbooks, parish calendars and short histories of the parish and school.

The photographs of St. Mary's School include 10 oversized photographs which are stored in the oversized shelving [OS]. The remainder of pictures, ranging from 1900 to 1996, include photos of the convent, school, student activities and celebrations held by the Sisters of Notre Dame in the city of Lawrence.

The papers for the Holy Rosary School include Annals, written sometime in the 1960s, the convent journals, which record almost daily events in the convent, the convent register of sisters within the community, PTA papers, school papers, minutes of convent community meetings and news clippings of school events. The photographs record events between 1950 and 1964.

There are few records for St. Augustine's School. These are the Convent Register, Annals, Journal, Councillor's Meetings Minutes from 1959-1969, a few school papers from 1975 and 2 histories of the parish.

St. Laurence O'Toole School records include the convent register, annals and school registers from 1888 to 1923.

The records for St. Rita's School include a few school papers and school registers from 1900 to 1923. Also filed with the St. Rita's records is a combined school register for St. Mary's, Holy Rosary, St. Rita's and St. Laurence between 1916-1919. The papers for a 1977 Inter-Parochial School Project are also stored here.

As the realization that St. Mary's School would be closing in 1996, the Sisters of Notre Dame began the work to explore ways to continue to serve the people of Lawrence. The Sisters in Ministry Committee met to work on establishing the Notre Dame Education Center. In 2002, the Sisters of Notre Dame began the work to establish the Notre Dame Cristo Rey High School, which opened in 2004.

The collection has been divided into 7 series.
